










#### 1. WHAT'S IN THE GARDEN

A garden is where people can grow flowers, fruits and vegetables. Can you think of other things that people can do in the garden? Also, can you name some animals that you might see in the garden?






TEACHER AID: Ask students if they have a garden and discuss the size and what is in that garden.

People who have gardens usually grow flowers, fruits and vegetables. This is your garden. Draw what you want in your garden.









#### 3. THE PARTS OF THE PLANT

Let's learn about the different parts of the plant. This is a daffodil. You can see them in Spring time. What colour is a daffodil?




#### 4. PLANT WORD SEARCH





Can you find all the words in this Word Search game?








#### 5. ABOUT THE TREE


READING

TEACHER AID: Discuss ways in which leaves can be used. Review page one before starting this page.






#### 7. WOOD FROM TREES

We have to cut down the tree to use the wood. The person who cuts down trees is called a lumberjack.


Circle the tools a lumberjack might use to cut down a tree.


TEACHER AID: Where do we get a lot of the plant food from? Discuss about the job of the farmer.
